In accordance with the above legislation, notice is hereby given that North East Derbyshire District Council resolved to adopt the Statement of Community Involvement on 29th June 2023. The SCI (2023) replaces all previous versions of the SCI.

The SCI (2023) covers all of North East Derbyshire District outside of the Peak District National Park. It sets out how and when the local community and other stakeholders can influence new planning documents covering North East Derbyshire and the ways in which comments can be made on planning applications, as well as other forms of submissions such as applications for listed building consent.
